## WELCOME TO GUALE PRESERVE

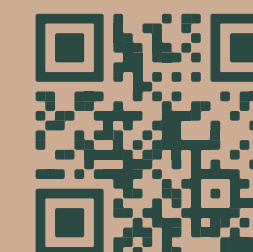
OPEN DAILY 7:00AM - 5:00PM

To protect the special features of the preserve,  
the following are **NOT ALLOWED**:

Animals (except trained service dogs) • Climbing  
Collecting • Metal Detectors • Smoking • Camping  
Hunting • Alcohol • Drones • Vehicles on Trails (except  
for emergency, management, and designated tours)

### REMINDERS:

- Parking is only permitted in designated areas.
- Hiking and biking are permitted on all trails at the Preserve.
- Firearms must be stored out of sight and in locked vehicles at all times.
- No water, bathrooms, or trash receptacles are at the Preserve. Pack it in, pack it out.
- Main entrance of the Preserve is accessed via Lawrence Road.
- Waterfront area of the Preserve is accessed via Village Drive.
